



# MI-TE-NA FAMILY GETAWAY

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHAT IS THE COST FOR A FAMILY GETAWAY WEEK?

The cost for the week is \$1,500 for a cabin. Each family (or individuals quarantining together) will be assigned a cabin together. Cabins will be limited to 7 people or less and must have at least 1 parent per cabin. This is a one time, all inclusive fee which covers the overnight stay, activities, and meals from Monday at 2:00 pm – Friday at 10:00 am for all individuals in the cabin.

### WHAT IS THE COST FOR THE FAMILY GETAWAY WEEKEND?

The cost for the weekend is \$1,000 for a cabin. Each family (or individuals quarantining together) will be assigned a cabin together. Cabins will be limited to 7 people or less and must have at least 1 adult per cabin. This is a one time, all inclusive fee which covers the overnight stay, activities, and meals from Friday at 7:00pm – Monday at 9:00am for all individuals in the cabin.

### WHAT ARE THE DATES AND OPTIONS FOR THE GETAWAY CAMPS?

We have 3 options for the getaway experience.

Option 1: Aug. 3 - Aug. 7 (Mon at 2:00 pm – Fri at 10:00 am)

Option 2: Aug. 10 - Aug. 14 (Mon at 2:00 pm – Fri at 10:00 am)

Option 3: Sept. 4 – Sept. 7 (Fri at 7:00 pm - Mon at 9:00 am)

### HOW ARE YOU ABLE TO OFFER FAMILY GETAWAYS BUT NOT TRADITIONAL CAMP?

This model of camp with parents onsite is more conducive to social distancing. Limiting families to their own cabins and dining at their own family table will help us keep everyone safe. Additionally, if symptoms occur parents will be onsite to assist with their own campers in screening, isolation, and testing. While hosting families we intend to follow all Covid-19 NH Guidelines for Lodging, Restaurants, and Recreation Facilities.

### HOW WILL MEALS WORK?

Each family will be given their own table in the dining hall. All tables will be positioned 6 feet apart. We will serve family style and ask 1 adult from each family to act as the waiter/server for your table. Additionally, families will be able to dine outside in our picnic grove.

### HOW MANY FAMILIES WILL BE ABLE TO ATTEND?

To safely offer this experience we are limiting our capacity to 20 families each week or weekend. If all sessions fill we will look into adding additional weeks or weekends.

### WILL MY FAMILY GET A PRIVATE BATHROOM DURING OUR STAY?

Unfortunately, no. Due to the layout of our facilities, we are not able to offer private bathrooms. However, we will increase our bathroom cleaning schedule. The facilities will be sanitized multiple times a day.

### WILL THERE BE AN INCREASE IN CLEANING AND SANITIZATION?

Yes, we will be hiring additional staff members to solely focus on keeping camp clean. High touch areas will be sanitized several times a day. Additionally, over 30 hand sanitizing stations will be spread out around camp.

### WILL I HAVE TO WEAR A MASK THE ENTIRE TIME?

You will not be required to wear a mask the entire time. We will require everyone to have a mask with them at camp and will ask you to wear it when social distancing is not possible. This may occur at certain activities and when in transit indoors. For the most part camp allows for plenty of social distancing.

### **WHAT STEPS WILL BE TAKEN TO MITIGATE COVID-19 FROM ENTERING CAMP?**

All staff and campers will be required to track and record their health in the days leading up to camp. All attendees will be asked to self-quarantine and monitor potential symptoms for 14 days prior to camp. Upon arrival, campers and staff will undergo an in-depth screening process.

### **WHAT IF I SIGN UP FOR CAMP AND I CANNOT ATTEND BECAUSE SOMEONE IN MY FAMILY IS DISPLAYING COVID-19 SYMPTOMS WITHIN 14 DAYS OF ARRIVAL?**

In this scenario we would offer a full refund.

### **WE MAY HAVE TO CHECK IN WITH WORK WHILE WE ARE THERE. DO YOU HAVE HIGH SPEED INTERNET?**

Camp is equipped with two locations that offer wireless high speed internet. Our Rec Hall and Welcome Center have ample space and internet speed for you to get some work done while at camp.

### **I SEE THAT ALCOHOL IS PERMITTED. THIS IS FAR DIFFERENT THAN REGULAR CAMP. COULD YOU PLEASE ELABORATE?**

Since many families will use this as a vacation we are permitting responsible drinking during the evenings by adults that are over 21 years of age. You may bring beer and wine to camp and enjoy it in your cabin, at the fire circle or in our dining hall. Camp will not provide any alcohol. Glass is not permitted around camp. We will provide cups to use instead of glass. Additionally, we ask that you observe quiet hours which is from 10:00pm - 6:00am daily.

### **WHAT AGE RANGE CAN ATTEND?**

All ages are welcome to attend the family getaway weeks and weekend.

### **CAMP MI-TE-NA IS TYPICALLY ALL BOYS, IS THIS CO-ED?**

Yes, this is a co-ed program and open to all.

### **WILL PETS BE ALLOWED?**

Due to the nature of camp and the lodging, we will not be able to host pets. Service animals are permitted.

### **WHAT DOES A TYPICAL DAY LOOK LIKE?**

A sample schedule is listed here. Throughout the getaway we will be asking families for feedback on what they would like to have offered. Activities will allow for social distancing.
